

NPGH LEADERs Program

Leadership, Education, and Development for Early-career Researchers

The NPGH LEADERs Fellowship Program is a 12-month clinical research training program for US & LMIC post-doctorate trainees and US doctoral students in the health professions, sponsored by the NIH Fogarty International Center.

Overview

- US trainees spend 12 months at their research sites.
- LMIC trainees spend 1-3 months at one of the US consortium universities and 9-11 months at their research site.
- Work closely with mentors in the U.S. and one of nine low- or middle-income countries (we can connect you with potential mentors, alumni, and sites, please contact us)
- Receive a monthly stipend, modest research budget, and travel costs between the U.S. and research site

Eligibility

- Must be a citizen or permanent resident of: the United States, Cameroon, Ghana, India, Kenya, Liberia, Nepal, Peru, Thailand, Uganda.
- Must conduct research at an approved site in country (list available on our website).
- US applicants must currently be enrolled in a doctoral/advanced degree program or have completed one in the last 6 years.
- LMIC applicants must have completed a doctoral or advanced professional degree in the last 6 years.
